10years old. 2nd born in
a family of four.
Has spina bifida and
cannot walk. His elder
sister is deaf. Collins
needs a wheelchair
and sponsorship for
special affordable
education, medication
and upkeep.



New Children who need sponsorship

8years old. 3rd born of 6 children. He is physically disabled, does not stand or walk. He needs a wheelchair. Needs sponsorship for his education, medical attention and upkeep.



Harrison Njuguna Ngugi

13years old. Last born of 5. we suspected that he is autistic. He is very hyper, mentally disabled. Needs sponsorship for medical diagnosis, medical management, education and general upkeep.



Enoch Momanyi

14years old. The 10th born in a family of 11. He is hydrocephalus and has a shunt that drains the fluid.

He has undergone 3 surgeries and needs more. He is a slow learner and needs special education. Need a walking clutch for support. Needs sponsorship for medication, education and general upkeep.



Kevin Mugusi

11 years old. 1st born of 4. lives with his mother. Father deceased from suicide. He is mentally disabled, has speech impaired. He is also physically disabled not stable in walking, has problems in managing passing of urine and stool. He has never been in any school. He needs sponsorship for proper medical diagnosis, medication, education and upkeep.
